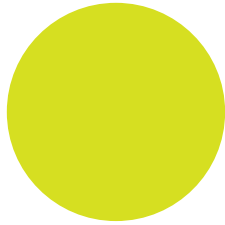
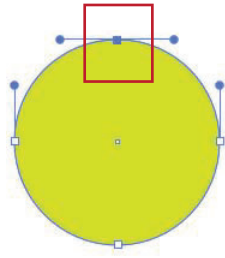


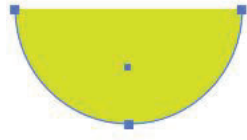
Creating a Segmented Curvy Wave



1. Create a Circle



2. Select the circle with the Direct Selection Tool (A).



3. Delete the right-most anchor point. Select the anchor point then hit the Delete key.

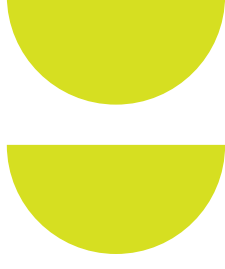


4. Copy the half circle shape and paste in place:

Ctrl + C

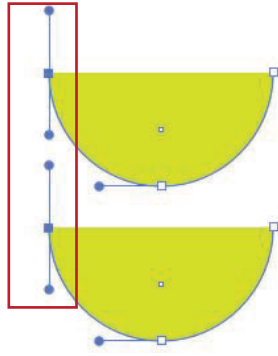
then

Ctrl + F

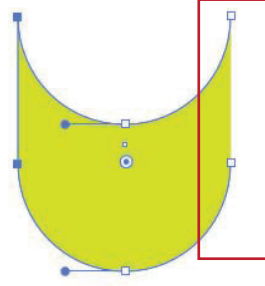


5. Use the right-arrow key to move a copy across (Or hold down Shift and drag).

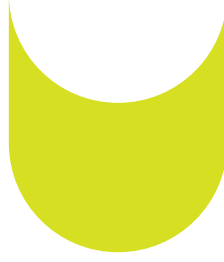
It's important that the two shapes are aligned horizontally.



6. With the Direct Selection Tool (A), select the top anchor points then the keys Ctrl + J to join them.



7. Still using the Direct Selection Tool (A), select the bottom anchor points and use Ctrl + J to join them.



9. This shape can be reflected vertically (Object>Transform>Vertical> and aligned to piece together a curvy shape.
