1.

CUT OUT THE TEMPLATE SHAPES.

FELT WORKS VERY WELL, AS DOES CRAFTING COTTON.

IF YOU ARE USING A PATTERNED FABRIC,

REMEMBER THAT THE FAT END OF THE PEAR IS THE BOTTOM

AND CUT THE FABRIC ACCORDINGLY.


PIN AND STITCH EACH PANEL SIDE TOGETHER,

TOP TO BOTTOM, ONE AT A TIME. DO THIS UNTIL YOU HAVE

THE ONE THAT JOINS THE PEAR TOGETHER, IE, THE LAST SIDE.



LEAVE AN OPENING ON THE LAST SIDE PANEL. THIS IS WHERE  
YOU'LL STUFF IT.

STUFF YOUR PEAR - I BUY A COUPLE OF CHEAP CUSHIONS FOR THE STUFFING.  
CLOSE THE PEAR WITH A LADDER STITCH OR  
OTHER NEAT HAND STITCHING.




5. TAKE YOUR 2 LEAF SHAPES AND STITCH THE SMALLER ONE ON TOP OF THE LARGER ONE. I LIKE TO USE QUILTER'S FELT OR WADDING FOR THE OUTER.

EMBROIDER SOME DECORATIVE STITCHES ONTO THE INNER LEAF (OPTIONAL). HAND STITCH TO THE TOP OF THE PEAR.

YOU CAN MAKE A STEM BY TAKING A RECTANGLE OF FELT AND ROLLING IT INTO A STEM SHAPE. AGAIN, SECURE WITH HAND STITCHING.

SEW ON BEADS, SEQUINS, BUTTONS, OR TOUCH UP WITH GOLD FABRIC PAINT FOR EXTRA SZUSH.


