

# Mask text behind an object in Photoshop

## Step 1

Open a new document in Photoshop and place the image you want to use.

## Step 2

Add your text.




## Step 3

Duplicate your image layer (Ctrl+J or drag the layer onto the +, the duplicate layer icon).


## Step 4

Drag the copy layer to the top of the layer stack.




## Step 5

Select the image copy layer, then go to Select>Subject.



## Step 6

Go to Layer>Layer Mask>Reveal Selection:



You now have your text behind your object.
